March is SUDC Awareness Month. SUDC is defined as the sudden and unexpected death of a child 12 months and older that remains unexplained after a thorough death investigation including an autopsy. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reveals that SUDC affects approximately 450 children

between the ages of 1 and 18 each year. Due to the majority of these deaths occurring between the ages of 1 and 4, SUDC ranks as the **fifth** leading cause of death; yet it remains notably absent from our medical education curriculum. Sadly, the lack of awareness within the medical community means that families often find the SUDC Foundation independently, if at all. Learn more.
